Presentations

Medals will be presented to those who beat another competitor in their event. For example, if there are only 3 starters in a race, gold and silver will be presented.

Certificates will be sent to schools for each participant following the event.

Due to paddlers competing in numerous races, there will not be presentation ceremonies, however results will be called and paddlers will be responsible for collecting their medal from the presentation area before the end of the day. Medals will not be mailed to recipients after the event.

Rules

- Championships conducted under the Australian Canoeing Canoe Sprint Racing Regulations
- All competitors under 14 years of age and any non-swimmers **must** wear a Type 2 PFD
- Others must wear a PFD in accordance with their schools requirements
- All craft must have adequate fixed buoyancy or be constructed of a material that will have it float horizontally when full of water. Protective footwear is recommended
- Students must race in school colours
