This event is being conducted under the Australian Canoeing Sprint Racing Competition Rules. The ICF Sprint Racing Competition Rules therefore apply as modified by the Australian Rules and this document. The event is also conducted under the bylaws of Australian Canoeing.

Start List and Draw

In the men's K1 200m, ICF plan A will apply – 1-3 direct to final with 1 semi final and 1-3 from semi final through to final.

Results

Results will be posted on the results board at the finish tower and online on www.regattas.canoe.org.au

Finish Line

Competitors should not congregate in their boats in the vicinity of the finishing line in case they interfere with the judging or the finish of the event in progress.

Start

The regatta will use the start command **READY, SET** followed by a horn. Competitors must not paddle in close proximity to the starting area while a race is in the process of being started.

Competitors' attention is drawn to the ruling on false starts. Any competitor who makes a second false start will be disqualified from the race.

1000m start is from a pontoon, the 200m start is from the automatic start system

Team Leaders, Enquiry, Protests

The Enquiry Desk will be located on the ground floor of the Finish Tower. All Enquiries or Protests must be written on the Enquiry / Protest Form and must be accompanied by a deposit of AUS \$50. This can only be lodged by the registered team leader from a state or the national team.

Any competitor that is unsure of any detail, or has a problem concerning the running of the trial should seek clarification via their Team Leader from the Chief Official.

Boat Number Distribution

Boat numbers will be distributed from numbers desk at the back of the grand stand.

Timing

Timing will be electronic with handheld backup and photo finish.

Equipment

It is the responsibility of all competitors to ensure that their boats meet the construction requirements of the ICF rules. Facilities are provided for competitors to check the weight of their boats from Wednesday 29 February from the lakeside behind boatshed 3.

Post boat control is selected at random by the chief official at the conclusion of each race.
