Please note that International competitors should supply sufficient evidence from their national organisation that they are current financial members.

### AGES

Junior ages are taken as at 1 January 2017.

A Masters competitor can compete in a Masters event in the year he/she reaches the lower limit of the age category, i.e. in the 35-39 age group in the year of his/her 35th birthday. In double events the age of the youngest competitor will control the category in which a crew can compete. Age group categories will commence from age 35 - 39 and increase upwards in 5-year age brackets. Age groups **may** be amalgamated should entries determine such.
